

World Trade Center Health Program

Providers in the New York City area, and across the country, monitor and treat conditions related to the September 11th terrorist attacks - like asthma, heartburn, certain cancers, depression and PTSD. These providers treat responders and volunteers who participated in rescue, recovery or clean-up on or after 9/11, as well as those in the WTC dust cloud or who lived, worked or went to school or daycare in lower Manhattan south of Houston or into parts of Brooklyn.
