
Dear Mr. Archer:

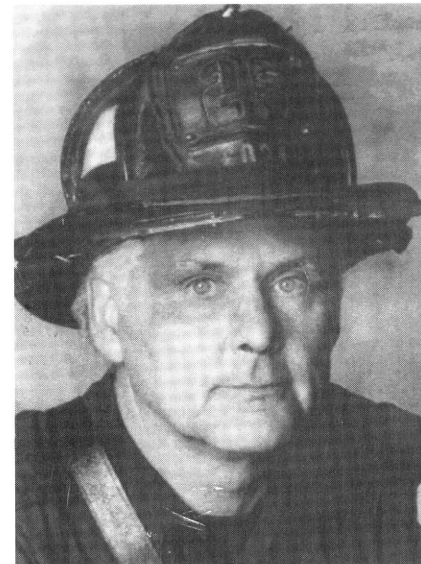


## **George Paris Cantor Fitzgerald**

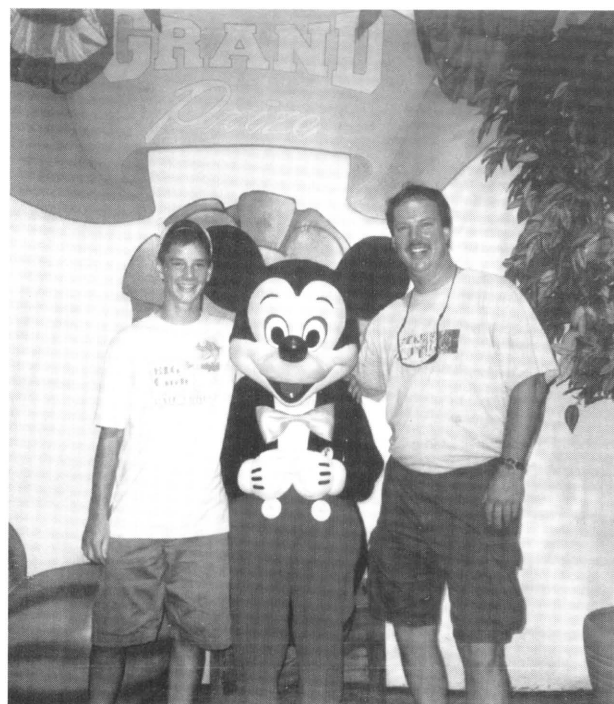
## **Firefighter Robert J. Minara**
