

The Network of Victim Assistance in Bucks County, Pennsylvania has been awarded a grant to assist victims of September 11th in paying their mental health costs. The program, called the Pennsylvania September 11th Mental Health Outreach Program, is open to victims, their families, and Ground Zero recovery workers who are residents of Pennsylvania. Anyone who lost a family member in the Flight 93 crash in Shanksville, PA is also eligible, regardless of home state.

What costs will the program cover?

Out-of-pocket individual counseling costs not covered by LifeNet or your insurance company for counseling sessions provided for a social worker, psychologist, and/or a psychiatrist (ie. co-pay amounts)

100% of the cost of your counseling sessions IF:

- You have no insurance coverage
- Your insurance coverage does not cover the cost of your sessions

How much coverage can I receive?

The maximum total coverage is \$2,500 for each client

When do program benefits start?

January 2005 - December 2005

Reimbursements can be made for any counseling sessions after January 1, 2005 and until December 31, 2005
