- 1. On 18 October 2012, an 802 Conference was held to schedule future hearings in the above entitled case.
- 2. With agreement by all parties the following sessions were set:
 - a. 3 7 December 2012 (alternate dates 28 January 1 February 2013).
 - b. 11 15 February 2013.
 - c. 22 26 April 2013.
- 3. On 31 October 2012, defense requested postponement of the December session. As discussed on 18 October 2012, defense had alerted the Commission that it may have a conflict with the December dates. With the agreement of all parties, the Commission set alternate dates beginning 28 January 2013 if the December dates were cancelled.
- 4. Accordingly, the Commission will meet on:
 - a. 28 31 January 2013.
 - b. 12 15 February 2013.
 - c. 22 26 April 2013.
- 5. Subsequent orders will designate matters to be considered at each session.

6. IAW R.M.C. 707(b) (4) (E), I specifically find that the interests of justice are served by granting a continuance and those interests outweigh the best interests of the public and the accused in a prompt trial.
