The Town of Westport would like to remind you of important numbers to have on hand for emergency updates and reporting. Residents must take precautions to be self-sufficient for up to 72 hours with enough food, water, and medications to shelter in place should a natural or man-made disaster take place. The Town's Emergency Management Team will inform the public of emergency procedures and directives.

The NIXLE emergency notification system is a high-speed telephone communication service that delivers customized emergency messages directly to homes and businesses at the rate of up to 60,000 calls per hour. Register online at www.westportct.gov or text "06880" to 888777.
