



Joined the Navy in August 1981, was a construction mechanic and stationed in Port Hueneme, California, he traveled to Puerto Rico and Okinawa. He married his High School sweetheart while he was still in the Navy, they stayed in California when he was honorably discharged. He drove a tow truck for a while then got a job with Southern Pacific railroad being a signalman. On May 21, 1986 on their third year wedding anniversary Barry had arrived. This baby boy was Stephen's pride and joy. While Stephen loved living at the beach he always wanted to be a New York City Police Officer. So Back to New York we would move. I remember during hurricane Floyd, Barry and Stephen were out checking on the elderly and a pregnant neighbor, clearing drain pipes so they would not get flooded. On the morning of September 11 Steve was seen on 684 helping someone with their car. This is not a surprise to me, since he always stopped to help. He thought if he could help, then maybe one day if his family needed help someone would. Since September 11 so many people have helped and looked after his family and for this we are grateful. Stephen loved playing golf especially with Barry, only Barry was a little better. He would love to listen to Irish music and was so proud when Barry began playing the Bagpipes. We know every time Barry plays his father is smiling down on us. Steve was the most caring and selfless person I have ever known and will love
