At the invitation of 9/11 Families and Public Safety personnel of New York and New Jersey, WORLD MEMORIAL was requested to meet in consideration for 5th Anniversary 9/11 memorial ceremonies with a proposed 2-hour signature *Release of Souls* Symphony Concert hosting original, uplifting music. The centerpiece of the event is the breathtaking Canadian Gift of Healing *Release of Souls* (ROS) eighteen-foot high sculpture.

Beginning in British Columbia with the 15th Field Artillery Regiment, ROYAL CANADIAN ARMY Band, this performance showcases international musicians - Canadian Composer Miles Black, world-renowned French-Lebanese Composer Bechara EL KHOURY, pipers from all over the nation and New York's very own Cantor Joseph MALOVANY who will debut the "Ground Zero Memorial Prayers" in honor of 9/11 Families, 82 Countries and those who continue to serve in harms way. *It is a salute for Liberty.*

Dear Mr. Johansen:

My name is Erroll Southers and I am the Deputy Director of the Governor's Office of Homeland Security for the State of California. I write to you in support of the efforts of Ms. Kathleen Tonnesen and the World Memorial Tour commemorating the brave police officers, firefighters and emergency services personnel who lost their lives during the September 11 terrorist attack.

I was fortunate to be approached by Ms. Tonnesen during the early days of my tenure, and asked if I would serve as the Master of Ceremonies for their first Release of Souls World Memorial North America Tour in 2004. The event was held in Pasadena and was a resounding success. The program consisted of songs and testimonies by many who were personally affected by the terrorist attack, highlighted by Ms. Tonnesen's breathtaking sculpture of the World Trade Center façade on display at the venue.

The tour moved to San Diego for the anniversary event, held on September 11, in Balboa Park. The participation and support by the police, sheriffs and fire departments was an incredible spectacle of unity and brotherhood, kicked off by a helicopter flyover in the "Missing Man" formation. Several retired NYPD and NYFD personnel also participated in the event.

Obviously, a great deal of effort and energy has been put forth to ensure the continuing success of this tribute. I have been honored to be able to participate as a representative of the Governor's Office, a former law enforcement officer and someone who lost two comrades in that cowardly attack.
