If you participated in rescue, recovery and/or clean-up work at the World Trade Center through September 12, 2002, please file a WTC-12 form and register with the New York State Workers' Compensation Board. This will preserve your right to future workers' compensation benefits, should you ever need them.

You should file a WTC-12 form whether you were injured or not, and whether you were employed or volunteered. This includes duty at Ground Zero, Fresh Kills Landfill, the barges, the piers, and the morgues.

The deadline to register your service is Sept. 11, 2010.

The WTC-12 form does not start a case, but it may preserve your right to file a case in the future.
