Here is the statement that will go on the victim website:

At 2:00 p.m. today, Attorney General Eric Holder will announce that he is referring the cases of the five conspirators in the attacks against our country on September 11, 2001 - Khalid Sheikh Mohammed, Walid Muhammed Salih Mubarak Bin Attash, Ramzi Bin Al Shibh Ali Abdul-Aziz Ali, and Mustafa Ahmed Al Hawsawi - to the Department of Defense to proceed in military commissions.

Since the Attorney General made the decision to try the 9/11 co-conspirators in federal court in November, 2009, Members of Congress have imposed restrictions blocking the administration from bringing any Guantanamo detainees to trial in the United States, regardless of the venue. The Administration opposes these restrictions and is going to seek their repeal, but does not believe a trial should be delayed any longer. Justice has been delayed in this case for far too long, and the Attorney General believes we must bring the 9/11 conspirators to justice now.
