DOCKETING ORDER

5. An 802 Session will be held at **1700** on Saturday, 9 August 2014, to discuss the sequence of argument and changes to the Docket Order.

6. If required, a hearing under the provisions of M.C.R.E. 505 (h) will be conducted at a time to be determined.

7. The time which has transpired since arraignment until the date of the next session (11 August 2014) shall be considered excludable delay in accordance with R.M.C. 707(b) (4) (E) (i) and R.M.C. 707(c). I find that the interests of justice have been served by granting continuances for the resolution of interlocutory and other pretrial issues, and that the resolution of these issues outweighs the interests of the public and the accused in a prompt trial. So ORDERED this 24th day of July, 2014.
