Important Registration Deadline: October 12, 2014

If you were diagnosed with a 9/11-related eligible cancer other than Prostate Cancer before October 12, 2012, the deadline for registration with the September 11th Victim Compensation Fund (VCF) is October 12, 2014.

Registration is easy and takes only a few minutes to complete online at www.vcf.gov.

About the Victim Compensation Fund

The VCF was established to compensate for physical harm and deaths caused by the terrorist-related aircraft crashes of September 11, 2001 and the debris removal efforts that took place in their immediate aftermath.

Potential claimants include first responders as well as individuals who lived, worked, or volunteered in the areas near the World Trade Center site, the Pentagon site, and the Shanksville, Pennsylvania crash site.
